The further three practices will have a random check completed rather than full • Contract compliance checks – Information passed to PCCCs for each CCG, practice will then be notified • QOF PPV visits – Assessor training completed, practices will be notified of visits • Johnson GP Centre – Current APMS contract to end of March 2019. Public consultation closed 31 December 2018. Decision awaited
General Practice Nursing - Proof of Concept	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 posts available • 59 applicants, shortlisted to 38 • Interviews to take place before end of Jan 19 • 17 practices have expressed an interest
Antibiotic overuse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recent publicity regarding antibiotic overuse has not been followed through by prescribing advisors. LMC will be asking Optum what action they are going to take to support practices.
CCGs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LMC have written to the CCGs to clarify their plans regarding 4-into-1
GPC update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr Andrew Green GPC rep for Lincolnshire and Humberside will be standing down in June. Nominations for his replacement are open now, and Dr Sharrock plans to stand. • Negotiations on the 2019/20 GP contract changes are coming to a head, and will be released on 31st January 2019. • GP Contract Roadshow to discuss contract changes will be held at the Golf Hotel, Woodhall Spa on 28th Feb 2019 to book go to the LMC website
