

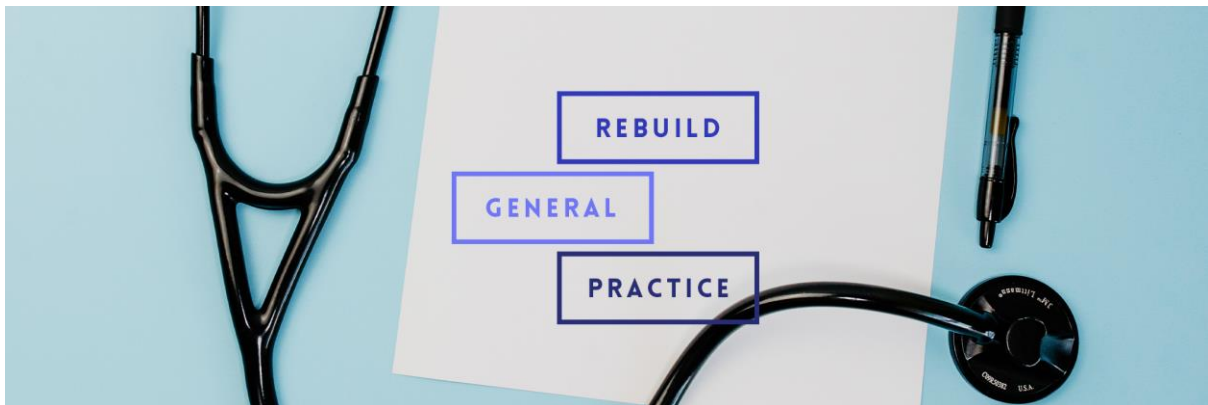

Rebuild General Practice Launch:



On 21st March the national campaign to Rebuild General Practice was launched. It is funded by LMCs in England, Wales and Scotland, and by the BMA.

The campaign seeks to:

- Promote primary care to potential recruits
- Retain experienced colleagues
- Improve public understanding of what we do and the pressures you face, and give them opportunities to show their support
- Promote balanced media reporting, shifting the narrative towards systemic issues rather than blaming you
- Persuade Government to deliver on workforce commitments, and encourage trust in your professionalism
- Improve your wellbeing

Lincolnshire LMC welcomes the campaign but recognises that it should include all staff working in General Practice. We know you are all under enormous pressure. We value every one of you, and hope this campaign will benefit you all!

Over the weeks and months to come, Lincolnshire LMC will share resources from the national campaign with your GP practice, and seek to engage with local politicians and media.

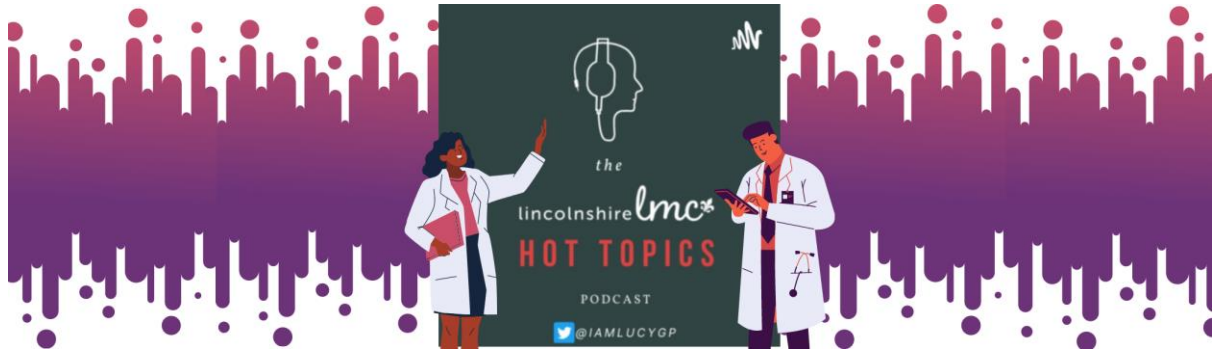
