NOMINATIONS OPEN - for a Board Member for Primary Care role on the NHS Lincolnshire ICB

For an individual to be eligible to be nominated they must be a registered practitioner on a permanent contract and working in General Practice, Pharmacy, Ophthalmic and Dentistry within the ICB footprint.

The individual must meet the criteria outlined in the role profile.

Nominations can only be made by individuals working in General Medical Practices that hold a contract for core services (GMS, PMS and APMS) and are currently commissioned by the ICB.

All nominations are required to be seconded and currently can only be by a General Medical Practice that holds a contract for core services
