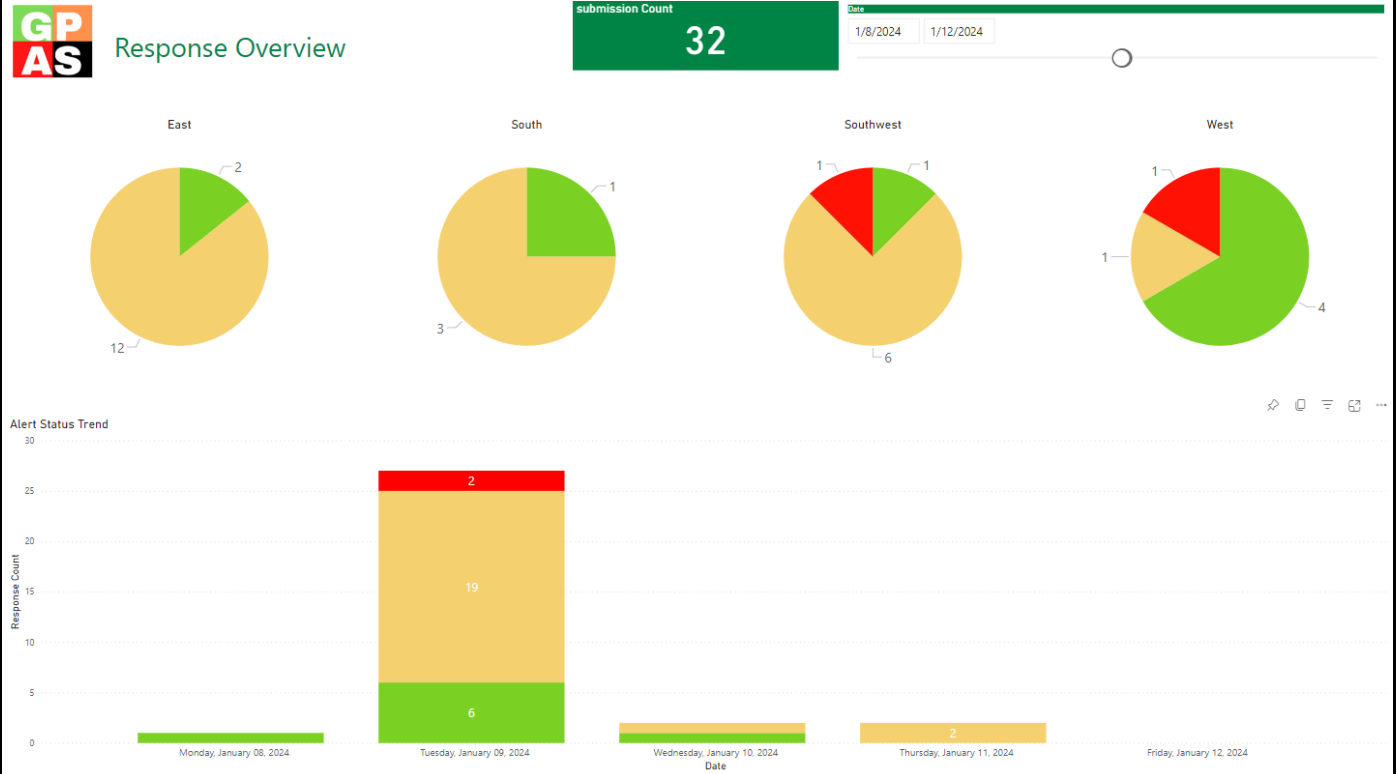

GPAS – COMMENT / ANALYSIS



The county wide assessment this week is **AMBER / OPEL 3** with **69%** of reporting practices assessed as **AMBER**, **6%** reporting as **RED**, **0%** as **BLACK** covering a total patient population of **273,811**. **GREEN** assessments account for **25%**.

In addition to the standard report attached, we have received the following information affecting General practices:

Other comments:

- Network Failure to ¾ of the practice PCs. Appointments had to be cancelled as computers not accessible. Arden & GEM fixed by 1.30am.
- Staff with sickness (COVID and other general sickness). Patients with chest infections, coughs, colds and poorly children.
- High level of DNAs (These were all pre-bookable appointments which equates to 2 hours and 10 mins of clinical time).
- Struggling with increased patient demand/contacts, some from hospital appointments deferred due to strike action. Patients expecting GP to sort out issues with hospital delays.
