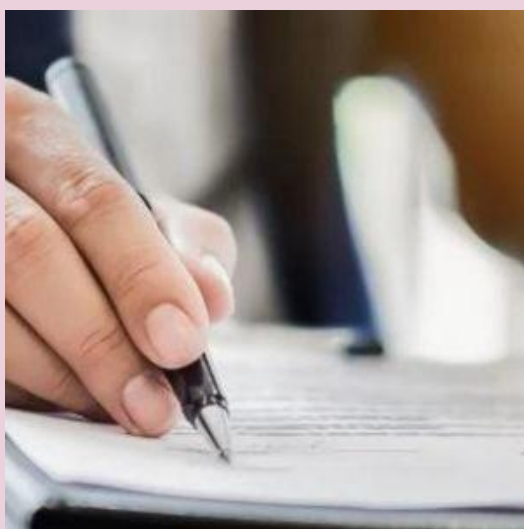


PCNA Legal Entity

We have recently been notified that the Primary Care Network Alliance (PCNA) have written to PCN Clinical Directors (CDs) inviting PCNs to become members of a new PCNA

legal entity, a company limited by guarantee. Several practices have contacted us to say that their Partners and Practice Managers have not been informed of this process and vote and have not been invited to discussions with the rest of their PCN. Each PCN needs to fully discuss this process with their member practices to ensure practices are aware of the potential pros and cons of a PCNA company.
