Referendum of the GP 2024/25 Contract

Your national team are anticipating a final contract proposal for 2024/25 from the DHSC (Department of Health and Social Care), together with NHSE (NHS England) to arrive later today – Friday 26 January.

Your national committee, GPC England, will be meeting to fully consider this offer next week, on Thursday 1 February. In line with LMC conference policy, we are preparing to hold a referendum which will enable colleagues to decide whether the offer sufficiently supports general practice in England for the forthcoming financial year, or not.
