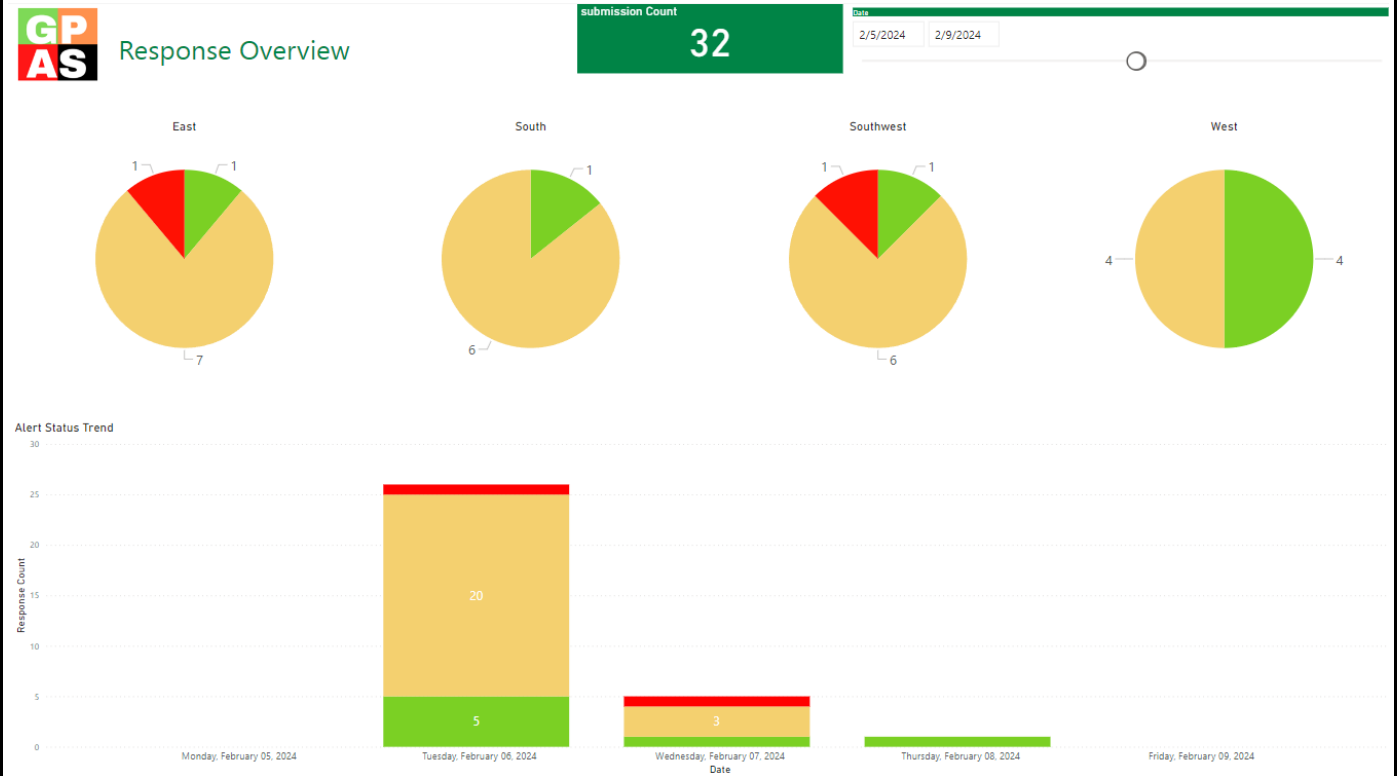

### GPAS – COMMENT / ANALYSIS



The county wide assessment this week is **AMBER / OPEL 3** with **72%** of reporting practices assessed as **AMBER**, **6%** reporting as **RED**, **0%** as **BLACK** covering a total patient population of **262,661**. **GREEN** assessments account for **22%**.

In addition to the standard report attached, we have received the following information affecting General practices:

#### Other comments:

- Staff leave and high level of staff illness (cold/flu) both clinical and non-clinical having a significant impact appointments.
- Online appointments not being used by patients.
- 21 x DNAs equates to 3hours and 30 minutes.
- Power cut on a Monday morning.
- Emergency calls diverted to 111 / UTC for a two-hour period due to high workload.
- Demand from patients remains higher than usual.
