

### **GPCE Statement regarding the 2024/25 GMS Contract**

GPC England have received the details of the 24/25 GMS contract. While much of the detail remains to be seen, the deeply concerning and economically unviable 1.9% GMS core uplift headline has understandably landed extremely poorly with the profession.

At a time when practice costs soar and workload continues to rise, general practice needed a significant and inspiring new contract to support sustainable and safe services for our patients while valuing our profession. This proposed uplift does neither.
