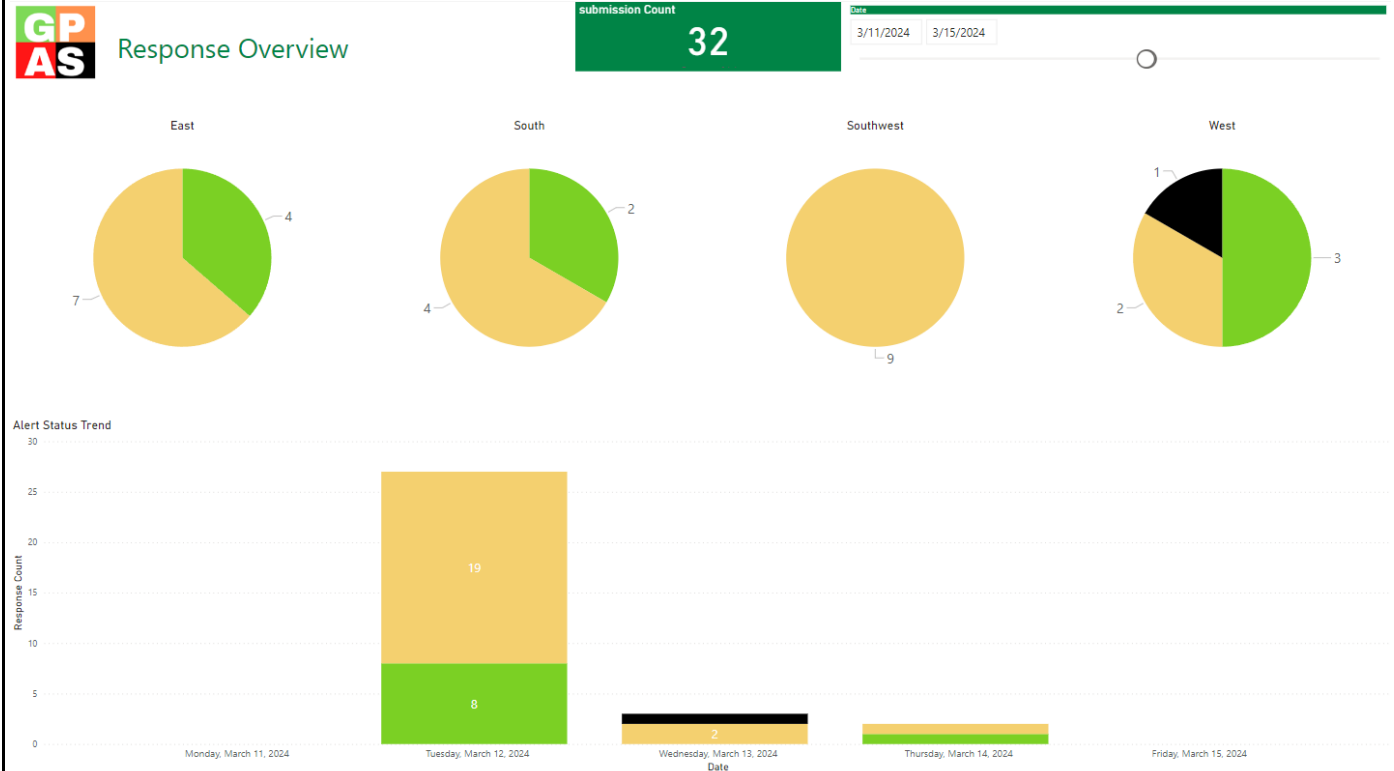

GPAS – COMMENT / ANALYSIS



The county wide assessment this week is **AMBER / OPEL 3** with **69%** of reporting practices assessed as **AMBER**, **0%** reporting as **RED**, **3%** as **BLACK** covering a total patient population of **248,976**. **GREEN** assessments account for **28%**.

In addition to the standard report attached, we have received the following information affecting General practices:

Other comments:

- Staff shortages (clinical and non-clinical) due to sickness and annual leave.
- Increased patient demand on an already strained service, dealing with many secondary care queries.
- DNAs are a huge problem.
- Patient demand cannot be met. Patient list size growing weekly in a building that is not fit for purpose.
- We are currently bringing in locums to try and help with some of the pressure clinicians are under.
