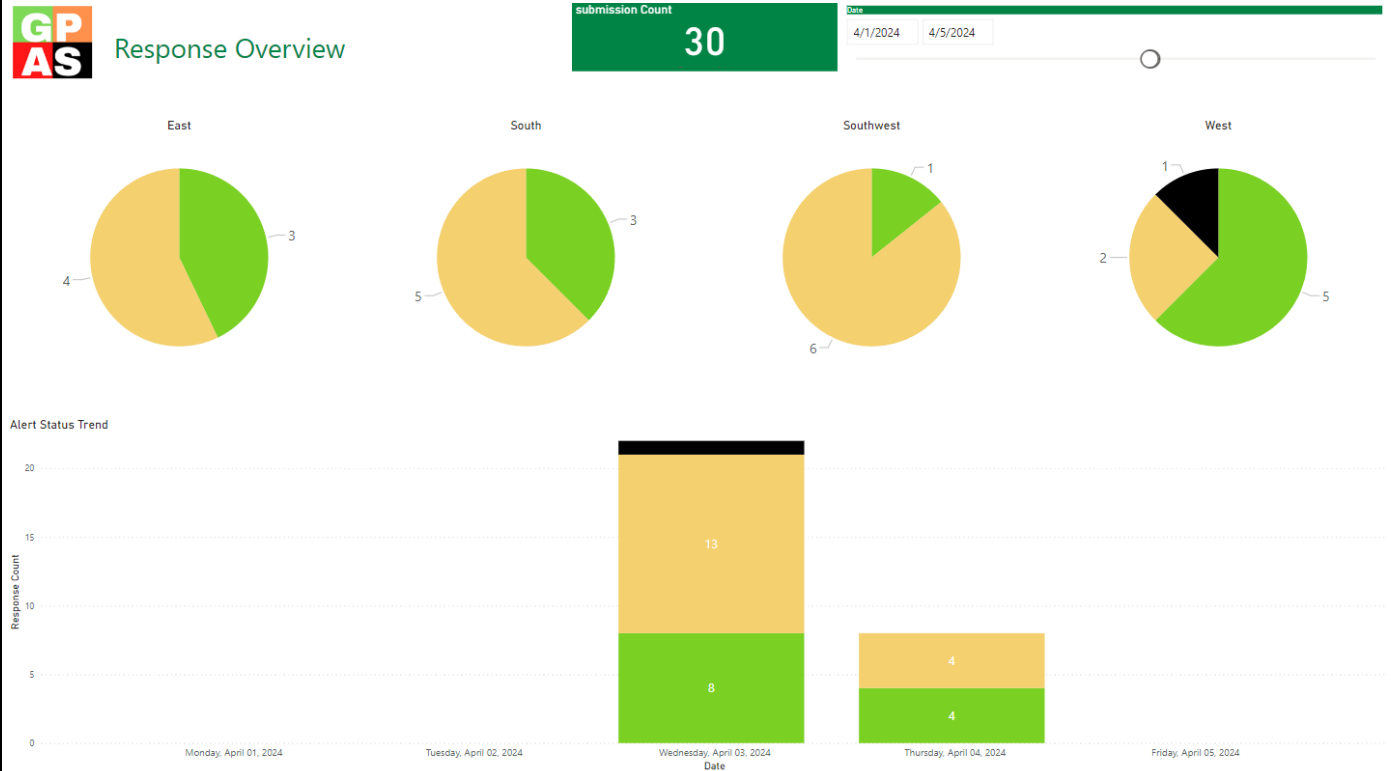

### GPAS – COMMENT / ANALYSIS



The county wide assessment this week is **AMBER / OPEL 3** with **57%** of reporting practices assessed as **AMBER**, **0%** reporting as **RED**, **3%** as **BLACK** covering a total patient population of **225,386**. **GREEN** assessments account for **40%**.

In addition to the standard report attached, we have received the following information affecting General practices:

#### Other comments:

- GP long-term sickness and annual leave due to the Easter holidays and high demand from patients.
- Increase in patients requesting advice respiratory complaints.
- 21 DNAs = 4hrs and 35 Minutes (across all clinicians - GP, ANP, Physio, Nurse and HCSW).
- Multiple reports of staff sickness and annual leave affecting capacity.
- Increased use of online consultation platform is affecting clinician availability for ring-back service.
- AskMyGP contacts are not visible in SystmOne so won't be reflected in patient contacts.
- Everything getting passed back to GP from hospitals and community.
