ICB request for Collective Action Information from Practices

You may have received an email request from the ICB to complete a survey or send an email as to what collective action your practice may be undertaking.

We have been contracted by several practices asking if they are required to provide the ICB with this information.

There is no contractual obligation to supply the ICB with this information. In addition this request also goes against NHSE guidance to ICBs; Amanda Pritchard stated in her letter to ICBs on 22 July 24, "We are not requesting that ICBs contact each individual practice to ascertain their intent and appreciate in many cases it may not yet be fully clear which actions individual practices are likely to take, nor is it clear whether all practices will take part".
