SLR PCN is offering £10,000 per session per annum pro-rata, and the postholder will be required to work 6-8 sessions per week, but we are happy to consider less or more. This role offers a unique opportunity to further enhance our PCN services and fulfil our DES responsibilities.

Main duties of the job
