Level 5 Practice Manager Apprenticeship



This course is made up of 10 modules covering different aspects of management, including a workplace project. This programme has been developed in partnership with the IGPM to make it more relevant to general practice than the usual generic management course. In addition, the programme will run alongside the IGPM accreditation domains so by the time students complete, they should have everything they need to submit their IGPM accreditation application.

Suitable for:

- Individuals already in a management role within a Lincolnshire general practice who do not already hold a L5 qualification and who are wanting to develop.
- · Individuals new to practice management.
- Team leaders and departmental managers aspiring to become practice managers in the future.
