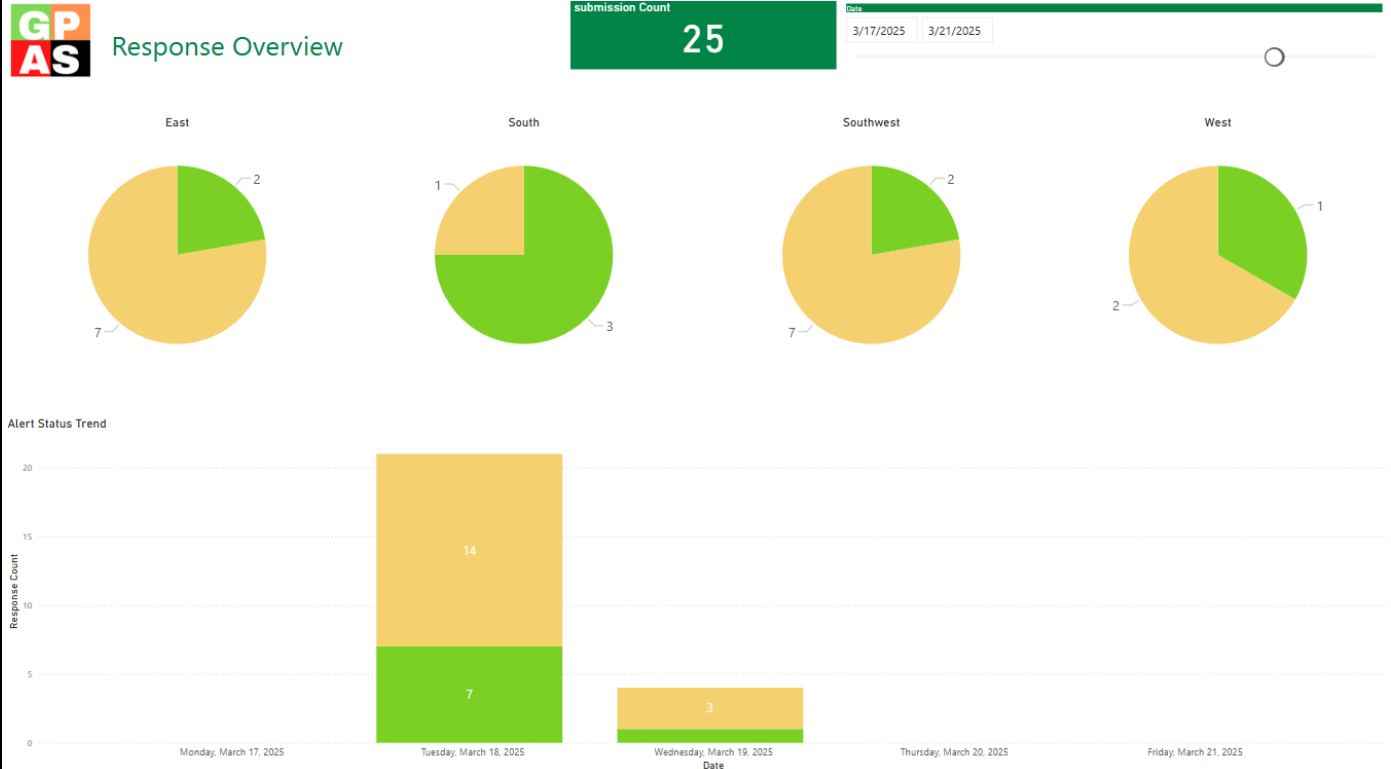

### GPAS – COMMENT / ANALYSIS



The county wide assessment this week is **AMBER / OPEL 3** with **68%** of reporting practices assessed as **AMBER**, **0%** reporting as **RED**, **0%** as **BLACK** covering a total patient population of **198,112**. **GREEN** assessments account for **32%**.

- Even with a higher number of clinical staff, demand is very high.
